

Murphy J. Foster, Leading Louisianian Dies at Seventy-Two

Franklin, La., June 13.—Murphy J. Foster, collector of the port of New Orleans, former Louisiana governor and United States senator, died at his home near here Sunday morning, and his funeral took place here today. Senator Foster had been in ill health for a long time, and in spite of his advanced age, 72 years, he made a brave fight for recovery. He has been identified with state politics for forty years.
