

Louisiana Election.

The Hon. ALEXANDER MOUTON, the democratic candidate, is elected Governor by a majority of about 1300. The federalists claim a majority of two in the Senate and six in the House. The federalists elected their candidates for the Senate and House in the city of New Orleans. These make a majority for the federalists in both branches. The New Orleans Jeffersonian, says—
