

The great question to which the death of the much lamented Mr. Derbigny gave rise, was definitively decided the day before yesterday, by the two Houses of the Legislature. We understand the two Houses passed a resolution to have a Governor elected by the people on the first Monday in July next, who shall remain in office the space of four years. The Senate chose a President in the place of Mr. BEAUVAIS, & the majority were in favor of Mr. JACQUES DORAN of Opelousas, who took the reins of Government, until the installation of the Governor elect.—N.
