

Hon. Michael Hahn, the Governor elect of Louisiana, was born at Klingeminster, in the Province of Rhemish Bavaria, in the year 1830. His family emigrated the following year to New York city, where they remained until 1840. They then removed to Texas, and soon after to New Orleans. He was left an orphan at an early age. He studied law in the office of Christian Rose-lius and practised it before he was twenty. He was actively engaged in his profession up to the time of his election to congress, in December, 1862.
