

FORMER GOVERNOR OF LOUISIANA DEAD

WASHINGTON, Aug. 11.—William Pitt Kellogg, formerly Governor of Louisiana, died at his home here yesterday. Born in Orwell, Vermont, 23 years ago, Mr. Kellogg moved to Louisiana in 1845, in which year he was appointed collector of the port of New Orleans. He served in the United States Senate from Louisiana from 1868 to 1872; was elected Governor in 1873 and was returned to the Senate in 1877.

Mr Kellogg had been a resident of Washington for more than thirty-five years.
