ST. BERNARD BAYOU YIELDS MAN'S BODY

The body of Raymond Morrison, 3315 Iberville street, was recovered at 3:30 a. m. Tuesday a short distance from the place where he and Ernest Schaeffer, 4709 North Tonli street, were drowned Sunday afternoon in Bayou Terre aux Boeufs.

Searchers from the sheriff's office of St. Bernard parish recovered the body of Schaeffer shortly before midnight Sunday, but it was not until Tuesday morning after dragging throughout the night that they located the body of Morrison.

Surviving Morrison is his widow, the former Alene David, and his parents, Mr. and Mrs. James Morrison of London, Ark. The body was sent to Gilham, Ark., for funeral rites. The Rev. Alcuin Kammer, O. F. M., pastor of St. Mary of the Angels church, conducted rites for Schaeffer at the church Tuesday afternoon. Interment was in St. John's cemetery.

WILL OBSERVE 100TH SCHOOL ANNIVERSARY

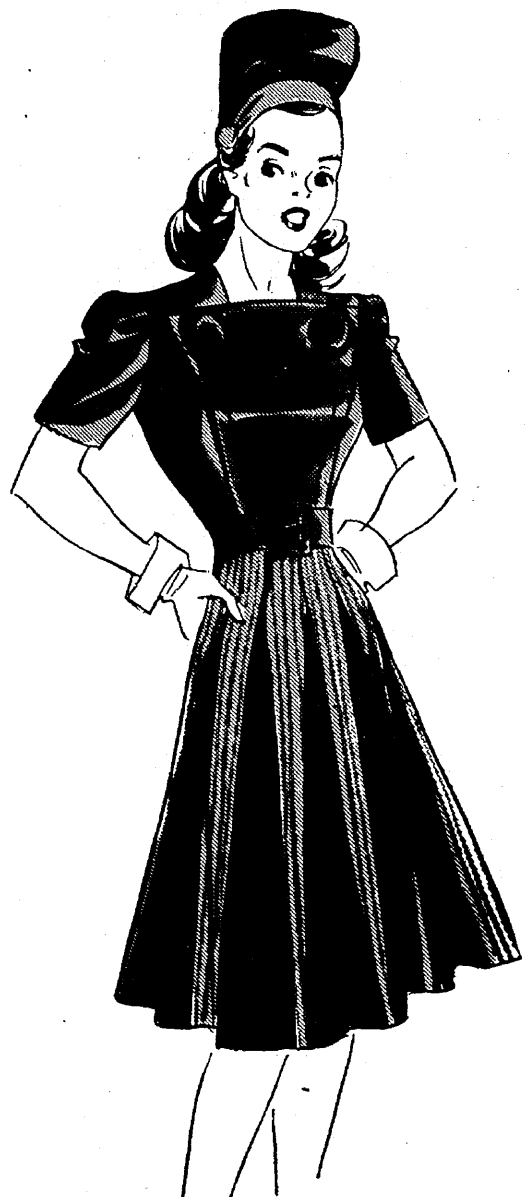
The New Orleans High School Scholarship Association Tuesday voted to observe the 100th anniversary of the New Orleans public school system during National Education Week, November 9-15.

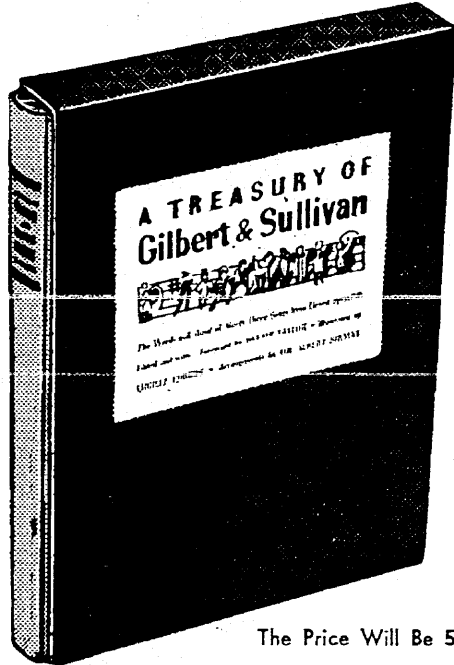

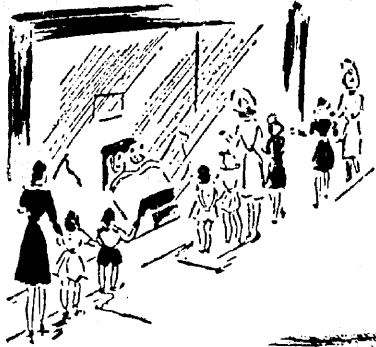

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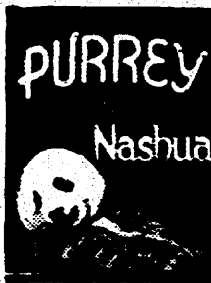
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
