The new Texas Beer Association, to protect distributors, opened its offices in the Mercantile Building.

A bill passed by the Forty-third Legislature to legalize boxing and wrestling became effective.

Argentina became the 22d nation to sign the international wheat pact to restore stability in the world grain market.
