

CAPTAIN J. Y. SANDERS HOME.

Attends Reunion of His Family in St. Mary Parish.

Captain Jared Young Sanders, 346th Infantry, Eighty-seventh Division, son of Congressman J. Y. Sanders, of the Sixth District, and grandson of Mrs. Bessie Wofford Sanders and the late Jared Young Sanders, who was a Confederate officer, participated in the family reunion held in his honor at his grandmother's residence, near Franklin, St. Mary parish, Easter Sunday.

Captain Sanders returned from overseas on the Alaskan, which reached New York early in April. When the war broke out he gave up his law practice to enter the first officers' training school at Fort Logan H. Roots, and from there was detailed to Camp Pike to train two companies which afterward saw service in France.
